- 1) Reviewing and Signing off on the Diocesan Policies regarding Sexual Abuse,
 2) Completing the Protecting God's Children training and
 3) Filling in information (in our external background sheek provider)
 - 3) Filling in information (in our external background check provider) for us to run a background check.

We ask you to complete everything in one sitting, if possible, which should take about an hour and a half. Please complete this on a standard computer, as we've found smartphone errors, especially when on an unsecured network. If you can't complete it all and need to take a short break, or need to log out and log back in again due to technical difficulties, please log back in with your newly created Account ID and Password at the Virtus main
